FORMAT	18 Hole Tournament - Four Person Scramble Tournament
RULES	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A scramble means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best. 2. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the chosen tee shot. 3. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green. 4. Putts need to be made within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score. 5. If the ball you choose to play is in the rough, a hazard (sand, water, etc.), or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away. 6. In case a team has only 3 players, each player will rotate who takes the 4th shot from each position on the course. 7. Men tee off from the Wolfpack tees, Seniors: 60+ Gray tees and women from the Pink tees.
GOLF ETIQUETTE	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Please rake all marks made in Sand Bunkers and fix your divots. 2. Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed. We need to do our best in keeping this tournament moving! 3. Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range. 4. Please observe all local course rules.
Closest to the Pin Holes 2, 6, 8, 14 & 17	If your tee shot is closest to the Pin/Hole, measure with measuring tape and write your name on the marker card at the green.
Hole-In-One Contest (\$5,000.00) Holes 2, 6, 8, 14 & 17	No practice shots, mulligans or substituted shots for other contestants is permitted. Shot must be witnessed by two playing partners.
Longest Drive Hole #11	The player who hits their drive the furthest in the fairway wins. Please write your name on the marker card and place the marker card where you ball lays.
Putting Contest (\$2,500) Putting Green	Qualifying contest takes place prior teeing off or during play at the "turn". Person who wins qualifying contest will have one Prize Putt for the award during the Awards Banquet. No practice putts or mulligans allowed.
Mulligans	2 per player, \$5 each, not to be used on Longest Drive or Closest to the Pin
Boom Lift Ball Drop	\$10.00 Per Entry – 50/50 Split with SEAA Ironworker Craft Training Program to be held during the Awards Banquet
Team Prizes	Awarded to 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd Place teams
Door Prizes	Winners will be drawn upon completion of play at the Awards Banquet
