Founded in 1972, the Steel Erectors Association of America (SEAA) is the only national trade association representing the interests of steel erectors, fabricators, and related service providers. SEAA offers an Ironworker Apprenticeship program that is approved by the U.S. Department of Labor.

SEAA members represent both small businesses earning under \$3 million per year as well as large corporations generating more than \$10 million per year. Working in both unionized and open labor markets, members share a broad range of expertise in the construction of single and multi-story buildings, arenas, bridges, and rail and highway structures. Many are award-winning organizations, recognized for their contributions to the environment, safety, and the industry.

Fabricators, central to the building process, connect the designers, engineers, and erectors to the contractors. Fabricators purchase raw steel and then prepare it for the building process. Their role in sequencing material and providing construction drawings is crucial to the erectors' success.
